Dear praying friends,

Hello, once again. I hope this letter finds you well and in the service of the Lord. It is always a blessing to be able to share with you all what is happening here in Ghana. Thank you so much to all of you who read these letters and pray for us. It means so much to us to know that people care about us enough to keep up with us. Your prayers are more appreciated than you can know.

This year has brought with it an ever shifting dynamic in the ministry. Our work with Biblical Baptist Church in Atonsu has continued to be a constant source of blessing in our life. Lately it has been my pleasure to spend more time personally with some of the young men who have been teaching in the church this last year. I am glad to have the opportunity to study the Bible with them and answer as many of the numerous questions they have as I am able. I have been able to enjoy a deepening relationship with two of the men specifically. Our time for ministering at Biblical Baptist is growing short and I am glad for every chance I get to have a part in teaching and training the people.

The reason that our time is short at Biblical Baptist is because the the Sommer family will soon be returning to Ghana and the Aaron family will be leaving for their furlough shortly after the Sommers return. We are excited to have the Sommers back and look forward to renewing our relationship with them, but we are also saddened to have to say a temporary goodbye to the Aarons. They have been a great blessing to our family in the last year, and I personally have learned a great deal from Bro. Andrew. I count him to be a true friend and have enjoyed getting to spend so much time together in ministry this past year. When the Aaron family leaves in June, we will be filling in at the Bible study in Bokro. I will be taking care of preaching all the services and the great majority of our ministry efforts will be there. We will still enjoy some fellowship with the people in Atonsu, but most of our time will be spent in Bokro. There are several people who have been coming to the Bible study in the last few months who have shown a desire to learn. I am praying those people continue to come and seek the truth. Pray for my family and I as we try to preach Christ to the lost and plant truth in the new believers. I believe the Lord has great blessings in store for this new church plant.

It looks like our family will be adding our first little girl to this crew of boys that God has given us. We are so thankful for this blessing God has seen fit to give us, but also anxious as the time of the birth grows close. Please pray for us, and especially Kelly, as this is the first child we will have outside of the US. We know that God is in control of everything and we trust Him in everything. Please just pray that our nerves will be calm as we go through this process, in many ways for the first time.
